### Chariho Community Educational Projects (CCEP)

The Chariho Community Innovative Projects (CCIP) Fund was established in January, 2003. As an endowment, CCIP provides grants (up to \$1,000) to teachers, support personnel, student, parent, and community groups as seed funding for a broad range of innovative educational projects.

A second educational project endowment, the Chariho Community Strategic Projects (CCSP) Fund, was created in mid-2007. CCSP provides larger grants (up to \$5,000) and is aimed principally at improving core aspects of the curriculum within the District.

### Steven A. Haines Memorial Scholarships

Steven Haines grew up in Mystic and graduated from Southern Connecticut State. He started his teaching career at Chariho as a Title 1 Math teacher in 1985. He spent 2 years in that position before spending a year teaching troubled teenagers at a residential school in New Hampshire. He landed back at Chariho and spent the next 11 years teaching middle school math. Steve also enjoyed coaching both baseball & basketball at the middle school during his tenure there.

Steve enjoyed watching & playing sports and was an avid UCONN Huskies and Boston Red Sox fan. He was a hard worker holding a second job at a restaurant throughout most of his career. Steven was killed in an automobile accident on his way to work on January 19, 1999. He left behind his wife, Stacy (also a Chariho teacher) and 3 young children (Ciara, Michaela & Alex).

### Francis Pellegrino Memorial Scholarships

Francis Pellegrino, a basketball player of note at Westerly High School and Providence College, taught in the English Department at the Westerly Junior High School and coached basketball, baseball and football with John Stellitano.

As principal of the Chariho Regional High School from 1962-1985, Pellegrino walked the halls each morning greeting teachers and students alike with his infectious smile. He would cheerfully remark, "My door is always open," allowing everyone equal access to his exemplary leadership and wisdom. Those who worked under his leadership regarded him as the "Gold Standard" of Principals.

### Westerly College Club (WCC) Scholarships

The Westerly College Club/Lois Hamilton Fontaine Memorial Scholarship Endowment provides scholarships to students from the Stoningtons, Westerly, Pawcatuck, and the three Chariho Communities. In existence for over 100 years, the WCC supports students already in college for at least one semester.

### Chariho Career Development Awards

These \$1,000 competitive awards are given to students who demonstrate outstanding efforts, through a variety of activities including their electronic portfolio, in researching and making their career choice.
